



THE EMERGENCY FOOD ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (TEFAP) HOUSEHOLD ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The State of Georgia income eligibility criteria for the receipt of USDA TEFAP commodities by households is a completion of a signed, self-declaration income statement. In order to receive USDA TEFAP commodities, total household income must be AT or BELOW the level shown for the appropriate household size in the following income eligibility scale.

HOUSEHOLD INCOME ELIGIBILITY SCALE FOR RECEIVING USDA TEFAP COMMODITIES

This scale is effective July 1, 2006.

The income eligibility criteria must be used by all Recipient (partner) Agencies in determining household eligibility. Recipient Agencies have the option of using either monthly or weekly income calculations in determining household eligibility.
